By today's standards, Backyard IPA could be considered a mildly-hopped and bitter IPA. It is made with pale, wheat, crystal and cara-pils malts that provide a balance to the citrusy, tropical fruit hop profile of this beer.

The aroma characteristics are prominent orange citrus, with hints of tropical fruit.

The flavor reiterates the aroma characteristics, however the hop flavors are less prominent as the citrus and tropical fruits combine with the hop bitterness and meld with malt flavors which are slightly sweet and grainy.

Backyard IPA is a mild-hopped IPA by West Coast standards, and could reasonably be mistaken for a Pale Ale. However, we call it an IPA because it is closer to the origin of IPAs.
